Proper use of car seats can save a child's life.

In August 2017, State Farm conducted a survey to learn more about the current status of parental behaviors and knowledge when it comes to lifesaving child passenger safety.

- 44% of parents surveyed, kept their child rear facing until two years of age or longer.
- had a nationally certified Child Passenger Safety Technician check for proper use and installation of child's car seat.
- 33% of parents surveyed, removed bulky clothes like winter coats before buckling.
- 32% of parents surveyed, anchored the top tether to the back of a forward facing car seat.
- 10% of parents surveyed, used or bought a second-hand car seat.
